A majority of said Directors voted in favor of the following resolution(s):

1. Mr. Dub Evins, president of the Cocoanut Grove Chamber of Commerce, gave a presentation about a plan to re-vegetate and clean up South Bayshore

**Resolution:**

Mr. Sarnoff moved to resolve to approve the Avenue of the Arts South Bayshore Beautification concept and ask that they come back with a plan when one has been created. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mr. Hecht. In favor Mr. Sarnoff, Mr. Zilber, Mr. Collins, Ms. Person, Mr. Hecht, Ms. McDonald, Ms. Dubin. Opposed, Ms. Niemeyer.

2. Discussion regarding budget. Mr. Collins thinks we should encumber \$10K for election. This will not be necessary because we voted previously to have elections every four years.
3. Discussion re Website: what is the budget for the website? Ms. Niemeyer will send out RFP to everyone with goal of getting finalist vendors to next mid-month meeting.
4. July 6, 7:30 p.m. at City Hall will be televised meeting. HEP Board will be asked to start an hour earlier.
5. July 6 meeting we will have report from 27<sup>th</sup> Avenue Committee, regarding the proposed metrorail property development.

6. We agreed at public meetings anyone should be able to raise an agenda item. Mr. Sarnoff will have discretion on the agenda for working meetings.

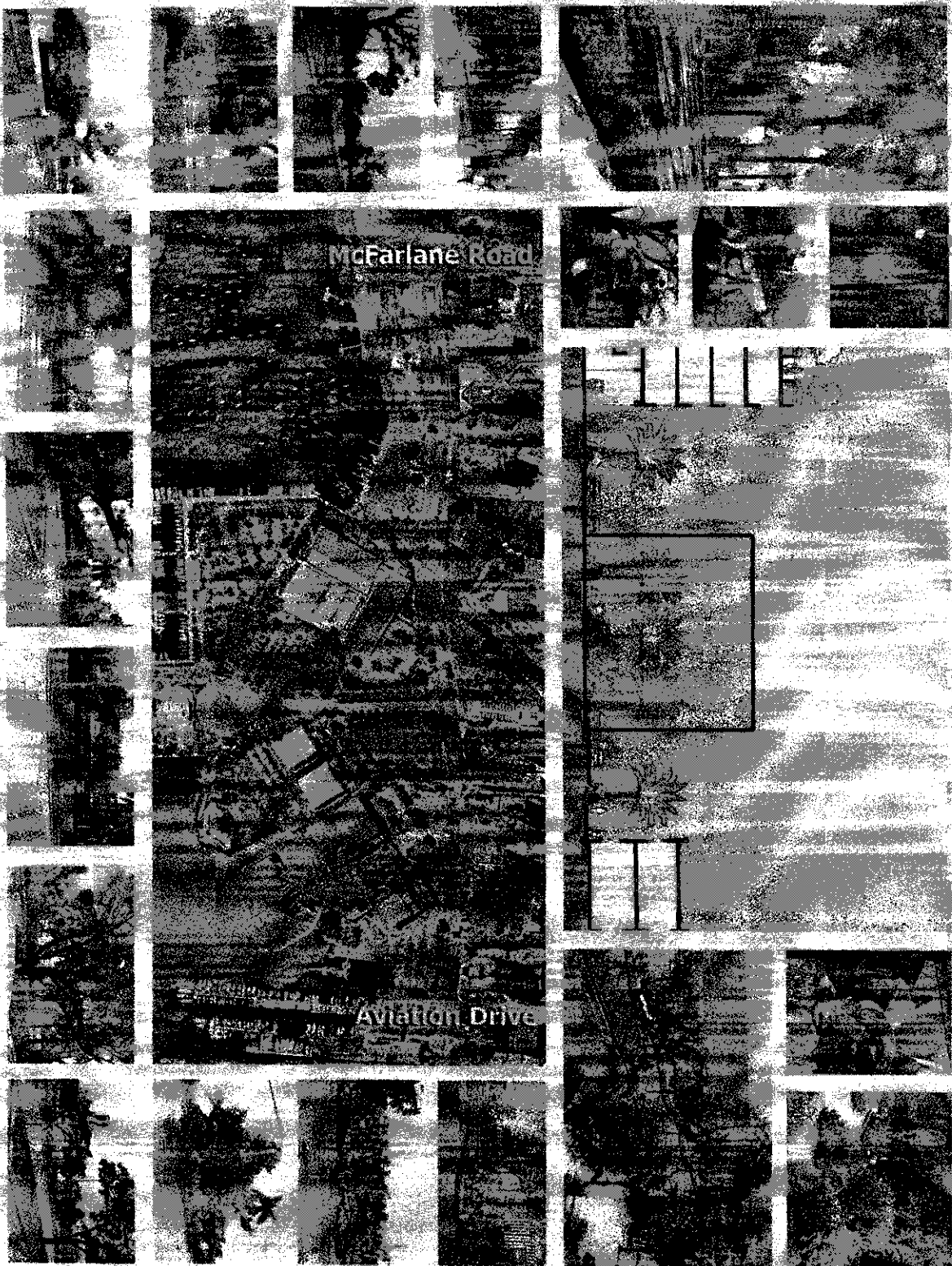
